

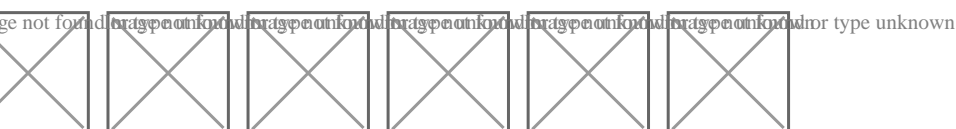

Itineraries

Day 01: Yangon arrival. Hotel check-in and overnight.

Upon arrival at the Yangon International Airport, welcome by our representative. Yangon, formerly known as Rangoon, is still a relatively quiet and charming city. Its impressive colonial and spiritual heritage makes Yangon one of the most fascinating and authentic capitals in South-East Asia. Transfer to hotel for check-in. Sightseeing starts visit Sule Pagoda, Mahabandoola Park with Independent Monument and have a memorable scene of colonial building & atmosphere. Visit Chaukhtatkyi Reclining Buddha Image: 230 ft (70m) long in the pose of rest. Visit Shwedagon Pagoda: a world famous listening gold stupa towering over the city spiring to a height of 326 feet. Overnight at the hotel in Yangon.

Day 02: Yangon/Bagan by flight. Bagan sightseeing and overnight.



After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Yangon's Mingaladon Airport for the flight to Mandalay. On arrival, a sightseeing tour of Mandalay, Myanmar's cultural capital, features Mahamuni Pagoda, famous for its venerable statue of Buddha covered with gold leaf. Mandalay has long been known as a centre of skilled craftsmanship and in former times supplied the royal courts. A tour of traditional workshops includes crafts such as woodcarving, marble masonry, Kalaga tapestry and gold-leaf making. Visit to Mandalay Royal Palace, Kuthodaw Pagoda with its 729 marble stone slabs of Buddhist scriptures (known as the world's biggest book) and Shwenandaw Monastery, noted for its exquisite woodcarving. Enjoy the sunset from U Bein Bridge, the oldest and longest teakwood bridge in the world. Overnight in Mandalay.

Accommodation: Hotel in Mandalay

Day 03: Mandalay/Bagan by flight. Bagan sightseeing and overnight.

After breakfast, transfer to domestic airport to travel from Mandalay to Bagan. Morning sightseeing of Bagan features the colourful Nyaung Oo Market, the Shwezigon Pagoda and its magnificent golden stupa, Myinkaba Gubyaukgyi Temple, a cave temple with exquisite jatakas murals paintings and the elegant Htilominlo Temple noted for its fine plaster carvings and glazed sandstone decorations. In the afternoon, observe the process of traditional lacquerware, one of Myanmar's best-known handicrafts and a specialty of Bagan. Visit Ananda, an architectural masterpiece of the early-style temple with four impressive standing Buddha images, Ananda Okkyau, one of the few surviving brick monasteries from the early Bagan period and Thatbyinnyu the highest temple in Bagan rising to 61m. Enjoy the horse cart ride with breeze wind among the temples passing by the traditional village of Taungbi, Sulamani Temple and the massive Dhammayangyi Temple noted for its remarkable brickwork. Enjoy sunset over the site from the upper terrace of Myauk



Guni Temple. Overnight in Bagan.

Accommodation: Hotel in Bagan

Day 04: Bagan-Popa sightseeing. Overnight at Bagan.

After breakfast, drive to Mt Popa. On the way, visit some villages and watch the collection of juice from the palm trees, and its conversion into palm sugar. Visit the great extinct volcano. Rising out of the shimmering heat, the solitary volcanic crag of Mt. Popa is home to Myanmar's most powerful "Nats". Visit the Nat Museum with its life-sized statues of the 37 Nat Gods. Walk up the steps to the stupas and shrines that top the hill above the museum, seeing many pilgrims along the way. Then come back to Bagan for dinner and overnight.

Accommodation: Hotel in Bagan

Day 05: Bagan/Inle by flight. Inle sightseeing.

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Nyaung U Airport for departure to Heho Airport and drive to Nyaung Shwe where gateway to Inle Lake. Enjoy a scenic drive to Inle Lake, one of Myanmar's best-known sights. The Intha people, a tribe of Mon descent, mostly inhabit the lakeshores and floating villages. On arrival at Nyaung Shwe village, transfer by boat to start a sightseeing tour to Indein. From the middle of the lake, continue down a small canal leading to the village of In Dein, a recently opened area in Shan State. Sightseeing to floating villages like Ywama, the lake's



downtown, where a floating market is held every five days, Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda and the weaving village of Inpawkhon and the jumping cat monastery. After walk around the village, passing a local school, take the covered stairway to the beautiful Alaung Sitthou area where ancient stupas are partly covered by vegetation. From here there is a magnificent view over the lake. Overnight at Inle Lake.

Meals: B, L, D

Accommodation: Hotel in Inle Lake

Day 06: Inle/Yangon by flight. Yangon sightseeing.

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Heho airport for departure to Yangon. City tour begins with Kaba Aye (World Peace) Pagoda, Maha Pasana Cave and Buddha Tooth Relic Pagoda. Then free and easy shopping at Bogyoke Market (Scott Market). Conclude the tour of this picturesque garden city. After Dinner, visit Botahtaung Pagoda. Then enjoy at Night Market or China Town Market with several taste of food and various fresh fruits. Overnight in Yangon.

Accommodation: Hotel in Yangon

Day 07: Transfer to Yangon Airport for departure.

After breakfast, own leisure time before transfer to Yangon International Airport for departure home sweet home.

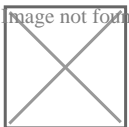

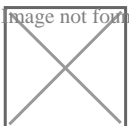

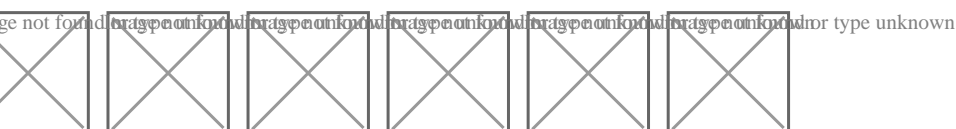
